Global Communication in Korean

A Workshop for Elementary to Intermediate Learners

4 – 6 June 2019

Organized by the CEEPUS network CIII-CZ-0604-08-1819 (“South and North Korea, Korean and Koreans: Research, Research Based Teaching & Networking for Synergies in Central and Eastern Europe”) and the Department of Asian Studies, Faculty of Arts at Palacký University Olomouc, with additional support from SEED Olomouc, a project funded by the Korean Studies Promotion Service, Academy of Korean Studies, plus support from Erasmus Plus.

Aims:

- provide students with a kind of supplementary input that is usually not provided in regular classes
- offer an opportunity for teachers to present thinking-out-of-the box exercises and special extra content while interacting with learners they are not familiar with from daily routine
- forming energizing new learning communities composed of learners from different source languages (12 students from Cracow plus 14 students from Olomouc).

Program:

The participating students are divided into two groups (elementary and intermediate; 12 students each) and work together with the four teachers on the three days from Tuesday, June 4, to Thursday, June 6, between 9:00 to 14:45 (with appropriate breaks). A framing supplementary program will include a guided tour in easy Korean.
