

IJP2021 offers an exclusive opportunity to students from KSU partner universities to study the Japanese language and connect directly with KSU students, Japan and their international peers.

Dates: June 21 – July 2, 2021

Japanese class levels: Aiming for JLPT N4 / Aiming for N3 Japanese class times: Weekdays 19:00 to 21:00 (JST)

Participation Fee: 20,000yen

Participants will:

- **Receive 20 hours** of intensive Japanese language instruction
- Chat daily with KSU student conversation partners
- **Learn** about Kyoto, a hub of **Japanese culture**
- Experience daily life of a Japanese student through vlogs



Note:

- *Minimum of 10 participants required for the program to run. Minimum of 5 students required in each level.
- *Maximum of 30 places available (max 15 per class).
- *Nominations close March 1st, 2021 or when the program is full. Whichever comes first.
- *Successful nominees will be advised about how to apply and about technical requirements for participating.

How to Apply

- Step 1: Students interested in participating contact the international office at their home university.
- Step 2: Students provide their home university's international office with the following details
 - a. Full name
 - b. Gender (as in passport)
 - c. Level of Japanese proficiency: (JLPT score or similar if any)

 Applications accepted from beginners to lower intermediate level students. (JLPT ~looking to take N3)
 - d. Reason for applying (Up to 50 words In English, or 50 characters in Chinese or Japanese)

Step 3: Home university nominates interested students to KSU by March 1, 2021

Students accepted by KSU will be sent application forms to be submitted by March 31, 2021

Step 4: Pay IJP fees to KSU (Details will be sent to successful applicants in March)

Step 5: Join IJP
