These guidelines are stipulated by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of ROC Taiwan for the implementation of the Huayu (Mandarin) Scholarship Program (HSP) which aims to encourage outstanding Czech students to study Mandarin (12 hours per week) in Taiwan, as well as to promote bilateral exchanges and friendship between the peoples of Taiwan and its diplomatic allies.

The MOFA Scholarship includes the following benefits:
